Loan Repayment Options

ND Federal Loan Repayment Program

Up to \$50,000 for a two-year service obligation. Funding amount is based on discipline.

- Physicians (MD, DO)
- Advanced Practice (NP, CNM, PA)
- Registered Nurses (RN)
- Clinical Psychologist (PsyD or PhD)
- Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC)
- Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW)
- Licensed Addiction Counselor (LAC)

ND Healthcare Professional Loan Repayment Program

Service obligation- 5 years

- Physician (MD, DO)- Up to \$150,000
- Advanced Practitioner (DNP, NP, PA) or Registered Nurse- Up to \$22,000
- Clinical Psychologist (PhD)- Up to \$75,000 loan repayment
- A behavioral health professional (Up to \$22,000 loan repayment) means an individual who practices in the behavioral health field and is:
 - o A licensed addiction counselor (LAC)
 - o A licensed professional counselor (LPC)
 - A licensed social worker (LSW)

Substance Use Disorder Treatment and Recovery (STAR) Loan Repayment

Up to \$250,000 for working full-time for six-years at an approved location.

- Licensed clinical social workers (LCSW), Licensed or master's level social workers
- Licensed Addiction Counselors (LAC)
- Licensed Professional Counselors (LPC)
- Physicians, Physician Assistants
- Nurse Practitioners, Psychiatric Nurse Specialists (PNS)
- Health Service Psychologists (HSP)
- Registered Nurses, Licensed Practical Nurses (LPN)
- Certified Nursing Assistants (CNA)
- Peer Recovery Specialists
- Case Managers

NHSC Loan Repayment Program

Up to \$50,000 for a two-year initial term (after initial contract, you may apply for additional loan repayment)

- Physicians
- Licensed Clinical Social Workers (LCSW)
- Licensed Professional Counselors (LPC)
- Nurse Practitioners/Physician Assistants (Specialty in mental health/psychiatry)

NHSC Substance Use Disorder Workforce Loan Repayment Program

Up to \$75,000 in student loan repayment in exchange for a three-year commitment at an eligible substance use disorder treatment site.

- Physician assistants
- Psychiatrists
- Nurse practitioners
- Psychiatric nurse specialists
- Licensed clinical social workers
- Licensed professional counselors
- SUD counselors (Master's Degree required)
- Registered nurses
